University Final Examination Instructions

The final exam schedule is typically based on the standard class meeting days and/or time (unless otherwise designated block exam). The class instructor will communicate in class if a final exam is to be held.

- Standard Final Exams: The exam period is determined by the meeting pattern (days and time) of the course during the week and expressed above in the table. For example, Monday\Wednesday\Friday classes meeting from 8:00 a.m. to 8:50 a.m. will have the exam schedule slot for Tuesday from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. The exam location for a standard exam is the primary classroom where the class met during the semester. Students in classes with no locations (online, Thesis, etc.), contact the course instructor for more information.
- <u>Block Final Exams</u>: All classes noted as Block Exams above will have the examination on the assigned block exam day and time, regardless of the meeting schedule of the class sections during the semester. These are denoted by the course prefix and code highlighted in the table above. The exam location for block exams is noted under the listed prefix/code, and your instructor will tell you what room to meet in.
- If a student has an exam time conflict, the student must inform both of their instructors. The instructor of the highest numbered course is required to provide a make-up exam during the final exam week that does not create further exam scheduling conflicts. If a student has more than two exams on the same day, they may inform their instructors to schedule a make-up exam for their highest numbered course if desired.
