


Incoming Students and Transfers

Before you begin, you will need a **10-character Cohort Code**. This code is found at the top of <https://floridapoly.edu/registrar/aleks.php>. Just look for the term (Spring or Summer-Fall) in which you are enrolling.



Step 1: Go to www.aleks.com and select **SIGN UP NOW!** under the Registered Users box.

Step 2: Enter the 10-character class code provided by your instructor and click **Continue**.



Step 3: Verify your enrollment information. If it is incorrect, check your class code and click on **(modify)** to make any corrections. Remember that your class code is found on the Florida Polytechnic University webpage for ALEKS; the example below is only for a particular semester. If your information is correct, click on **Continue**.



Step 4: Select “I have never used ALEKS before...”
Click on **Continue**.
