Florida Poly's Spring 2018 Commencement will be held at 3:30 p.m. on Friday, May 4, at the RP Funding Center, Youkey Theater, 701 W. Lime St., Lakeland, Florida. All guests must have a ticket (except lap infants).

WHEN TO ARRIVE

Graduates must check in at the Exhibit Hall between 1:30 and 2 p.m. Doors to the Youkey Theatre lobby will open at 2:30 p.m. The ceremony will begin promptly at 3:30 p.m. and is expected to last approximately two hours.

PARKING AND GUEST SEATING

Free parking is available in the Blue Parking Lot. Families and guests are urged to arrive in time to be seated by 3:20 p.m. The ceremony will begin promptly at 3:30 p.m.

SECURITY

Balloons, wrapped packages, posters and banners are not allowed. All items are subject to search.

REQUIRED APPAREL

Students must wear a cap and gown purchased from the university bookstore. The deadline to order apparel was March 16. Cap and gowns are available for pickup during normal bookstore hours, between April 23 and May 3. Students are required to wear professional dress and dress shoes under their gown.

OFFICIAL PHOTOGRAPHER
