NOTICE OF PROPOSED REGULATION**

**REGULATION NUMBER AND TITLE:** FPU-4.002 Waiver of Tuition and Fees.

**SUMMARY OF THE REGULATION:** This regulation allows the University to waive tuition and/or certain fees for certain categories of individuals subject to certain restrictions and limitations.

THE FULL TEXT OF THE PROPOSED REGULATION IS PROVIDED BELOW:

**FPU-4.002 Waiver of Tuition and Fees.**

- (1) **Mandatory Waivers.** Florida Polytechnic University will waive tuition and/or certain fees as required by Board of Governors regulations and Florida Statutes.
- (2) **Additional Waivers.** The University will also waive tuition and/or certain fees, as specified, for the following categories of individuals; however, such waivers shall be in accordance with Board of Governors regulations and Florida Statutes and subject to any limitations or restrictions therein:
  - (a) Full-time Florida Polytechnic University employees who meet academic requirements receive a waiver of the tuition and related fees for up to six (6) credit hours per semester on a space-available basis. Full-time employees may assign up to six (6) of their undergraduate credit hours or up to three (3) graduate credit hours per semester to their dependents who meet academic requirements and are admitted to the University.
  - (b) Full-time public classroom teachers employed by a school district who meet academic requirements will receive a waiver of tuition and related fees for up to six (6) credit hours of undergraduate courses in mathematics or science approved by the Department of Education per semester on a space-available basis. This waiver may not be used for courses scheduled during the school district's regular school day.
  - (c) Florida residents 60 years of age or older auditing college credit courses which do not require selective admissions criteria will receive a waiver of the tuition and related fees for such courses. No academic credit shall be awarded.
  - (d) Intern supervisors who hold a certificate pursuant to BOG regulation 7.008 will be given a waiver of in-state tuition for a maximum of six (6) credit hours for a single semester.
  - (e) Non-degree seeking non-resident students participating in certain programs, as described in BOG regulation 7.008(16), will receive a waiver of the out-of-state fee.
  - (f) Participants in certain Sponsored Credit Institutes and Programs as described in BOG regulation 7.008(2) will receive a waiver of tuition, associated fees and material and supply fees for credit courses taken in such Institutes or Programs.
- (3) **Waivers to Support the Mission of the University.** The President or designee is authorized to waive tuition, out-of-state fees, and/or associated fees for purposes that support and enhance the mission of the University.
- (4) **Annual Allocation.** The total annual dollars granted for waivers shall not exceed the total fee waiver dollars approved for the University by the Board of Trustees in its annual allocation.
- (5) **Reporting.** The University shall annually report the purpose, number, and value of the fee waivers granted in a format prescribed by the Board of Governors.
