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PURPOSE

This section presents various metrics used by the Office of Institutional Research to track student enrollment at the Institution.


Total Headcount


The Fall 2017 unduplicated headcount is 1,445 students. Total enrollment is defined as the duplicated headcount of students registered for classes. Florida Polytechnic University is beginning to see an increase in its upper class (junior and senior) students as its Inaugural Class progress toward graduation. Upper Class represents 38% of the total student population.

New Student Profile

A total of 401 new and readmitted students registered for Fall 2017. New students represent 28% of all student population. First-Time In College (FTIC) students are the higher percentage of incoming students (79%); a pattern observed since Fall 2014. In addition, international students enrollment increased to a total of 31 enrolled in both undergraduate and graduate levels. Academic quality of new students at Florida Polytechnic University with respect to test scores have increased when compared to previous incoming class.






Student Diversity






College and Major Enrollment

Within the two colleges; College of Engineering and College of Innovation & Technology, the University has six (6) Bachelor of Science degrees and two (2) Master of Science degrees. Each baccalaureate major has between 2 and 5 concentrations for students to specialize. Computer Science & Information Technology (44%) and Mechanical & Industrial Engineering (22%) continue to be the most popular majors.


Students Age at Florida Polytechnic ranges from 16 years of age to 55 years of age. There are 22 students under the age of 18 and 947 under the age of 21.

This section will present faculty and staff demographics, as well as a general headcount of faculty/staff at Fall 2017 Census.


Employees by Position Level

Florida Polytechnic has a total of 380 staff and faculty members (including FIPR – Florida Industrial & Phosphate Research Institute).

40% of total employees are considered full-time staff (including FIPR), 24% of total employees are faculty and 3% OPS. The University has hired 124 student workers. Students hired by the University work as research assistants, orientation leaders, IT interns, educational assistants, graduate assistants, and teacher assistants.
