Parking on University Property	6C13-1.003
Schedule of Parking Fees and Fines	6C13-1.004

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: To revise the existing parking regulations and transportation access fee rules. Creates a separate rule for parking fees and fines.

SUMMARY: Rule 6C13-1.003 revises the procedures for registration of vehicles on campus, classifications of digital parking passes and permits, and designation of parking areas. Rule 6C13-1.004 creates a fee schedule for parking fees and fines.

RULEMAKING AUTHORITY: 1006.66(2) FS.

LAW IMPLEMENTED: 1006.66, 1009.24(14)(r) FS.

SUMMARY OF STATEMENT OF ESTIMATED REGULATORY COSTS AND LEGISLATIVE RATIFICATION:

The Agency has determined that these rules will not have an adverse impact on small business or likely increase directly or indirectly regulatory costs in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate within one year after the implementation of the rules.
