**PURPOSE AND EFFECT:** To repeal Rules 6J-1.001 through 6J-1.007, F.A.C. The effect is to remove rules from the Florida Administrative Code that are no longer supported by statutory authority.

**SUMMARY:** The rulemaking authority for these rules no longer exists and therefore these rules must be repealed.

### SUMMARY OF STATEMENT OF ESTIMATED REGULATORY COSTS AND LEGISLATIVE RATIFICATION:

The Agency has determined that these rules will not have an adverse impact on small business or likely increase directly or indirectly regulatory costs in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate within one year after the implementation of the rules.
