## 100. System of Student Government Association (SGA) Statutes

#### 100.1. Objective

100.1.1. This chapter serves to outline the structure and jurisdiction of the Student Government Association statutes.

#### 100.2. Structure

100.2.1. These statutes shall be organized into titles and chapters, which may then be further subdivided via a decimal system.

#### 100.3. Jurisdiction

- 100.3.1. These statutes shall describe and identify Student Government Association entities, processes, and procedures.
- 100.3.2. Student Government Association statutes shall not conflict with any Federal laws, State laws, University policies, or the SGA Constitution.



#### 101. Amendments to the Student Government Association Statutes

#### 101.1. Objective

101.1.1. This Chapter outlines procedures for amending and maintaining SGA Statutes

#### 101.2. Amendments

- 101.2.1. An amendment to any part of the SGA Statutes may be proposed in the form of a Statutory Bill to the SGA Senate.
- 101.2.2. A Statutory Bill that is passed by the Senate shall become an act upon the approval of the Student Body President or upon a successful override of a Presidential Veto.

#### 101.3. Distribution

101.3.1. All Acts shall be distributed by the Senate President Pro Tempore via hand-delivery to all leaders of the Executive, Legislative, and Judicial branches within five (5) business days of their successful passage through the legislative process.

#### 101.4. Upkeep

- 101.4.1. There shall be an official record of current and past SGA statutes that is compiled, maintained, and published by the Officer of Standards and Enforcement.
- 101.4.2. This official record shall include all statutory amendments presented to the Senate.



### 102. Enforcement of the Student Government Association Statutes

#### 102.1. Enforcement

102.1.1. These statutes shall be applicable to and enforceable upon officers and associated officers of the Student Government Association and entities described within these statutes.



# 103. Symbols

- 103.1. The official SGA logo will be the logo that is used by the majority of SGA at any point in time.
- 103.2. The official SGA seal will be the seal that is used by the majority of SGA at any point in time.



# 104. Definitions of Terms in the Student Government Association Statutes

#### 104.1. Objective

- 104.1.1. This chapter serves to define acronyms and terms used throughout these statutes that would otherwise be unclear or ambiguous.
- 104.2. **A&S Fee:** The activity and service fee, established by Florida law, and allocated by the legislative branch towards activities and services.
- 104.3. <u>Academic Semester:</u> The Florida Polytechnic University Fall, Spring, Summer A, Summer B, or Summer C semester.
- 104.4. **Bill:** An allocation or an amendment to SGA statutes that has been sent to the Legislative Branch that has not fully gone through the legislative process.
- 104.5. **Business Day:** An entire weekday (Monday through Friday), starting at 9 AM and ending at 5 PM, and excluding any days in which classes are not being held.
- 104.6. <u>Due Process:</u> The conduct of any proceeding wherein there is fair treatment to all parties involved.
- 104.7. Officers: Any person that is a member of a body by virtue of their position.
- 104.8. **SGA Affiliate:** Any person that is a member of a body associated with SGA by virtue of their position. As defined by the Constitution
- 104.9. **Fiscal Year:** The year starting on July 1st and ending on June 30th.
- 104.10. <u>General Body Meeting:</u> Meetings as defined by SOP, Handbook, Statute of any respective body.
- 104.11. Majority: More than half.
- 104.12. **Majority Vote:** The affirmative vote of the majority of the present voting members.
- 104.13. On Campus: Defined by any property or facility owned or operated by Florida Polytechnic University.
- 104.14. **Quorum:** The presence of at least one-third (1/3) of a body's total number of voting members, except where specified otherwise in a more restrictive manner.
- 104.15. **SGA Constitution:** The Constitution of the Student Body of Florida Polytechnic University.
- 104.16. **SGA:** Student Government Association.
- 104.17. **SGA Official (Student Body Official):** Any member of SGA who is elected by the Student Body or confirmed by the Senate.
- 104.18. **SGA Term:** The period of time an SGA Official serves in their respective office.
- 104.19. **Student Government:** Student Government Association.
- 104.20. **Standard Operating Procedure (SOP):** A document detailing the inner workings of an SGA entity.
- 104.21. **Student Body:** All enrolled students of Florida Polytechnic University.
- 104.22. **Supermajority Vote:** The affirmative vote of at least two-thirds (2/3) of the entire body of voting members.
- 104.23. **Exclusionary Position:** An exclusionary position is one that must be held exclusive from all other exclusionary positions within a student government.
